## ASSIGNMENT OF SUPERUSER FOR eUST SYSTEM AND TERMS OF USE

terms and conditions and hereby authorize the named **employee** below to be granted rights as a system administrator (i.e. "SuperUser") for the Department of Revenue's (DOR) Underground Storage Tank (UST) Program's "eUST" application submission and management software account:

1. I certify that I am duly authorized to act on behalf of the Company with respect to accepting these terms and conditions and assigning these rights and responsibilities to the named employee as a SuperUser and the use of the eUST system.
2. The SuperUser will be responsible for assigning all other employees of the Company, their usernames, passwords, and associated rights.
3. All usernames and passwords will be kept confidential.
4. The SuperUser will be responsible for creating, updating, and managing all users for the Company with respect to access to the eUST system, including but not limited to, activating and inactivating users and assigning rights.
5. I understand that the SuperUser will initially be assigned rights by DOR to View, Prepare, Sign/Certify, and Submit 21J-related applications on behalf of the Company.
6. The Company and I are jointly responsible for all activities and transactions performed on the eUST system while using credentials (usernames and passwords) issued to Company's employees. Both the Company and I can be held accountable for any access gained and/or transactions attempted or completed using these credentials by me or anyone else who gains access to eUST system because of the Company's negligence in failing to safeguard this information.
7. I will immediately report to the UST Program, any information that would lead a reasonable person to believe that someone other than the authorized employee had obtained access to the eUST system using the employee's credentials.
8. At any time an employee leaves the employ of the Company, their credentials will be disabled, or if their job responsibilities change, their granted rights will be modified accordingly.
